The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has reviewed the December 2, 2019 document titled "Military Munitions Response Program Cleanup Plan for the Former York Naval Ordnance Plant" (report) for the property referenced above. The report was prepared by Groundwater Sciences Corporation and submitted to the DEP in accordance with the Land Recycling and Environmental Remediation Standards Act (Act 2) and constitutes a Cleanup Plan as defined in Chapter 3. This report was reviewed by a licensed professional geologist.


